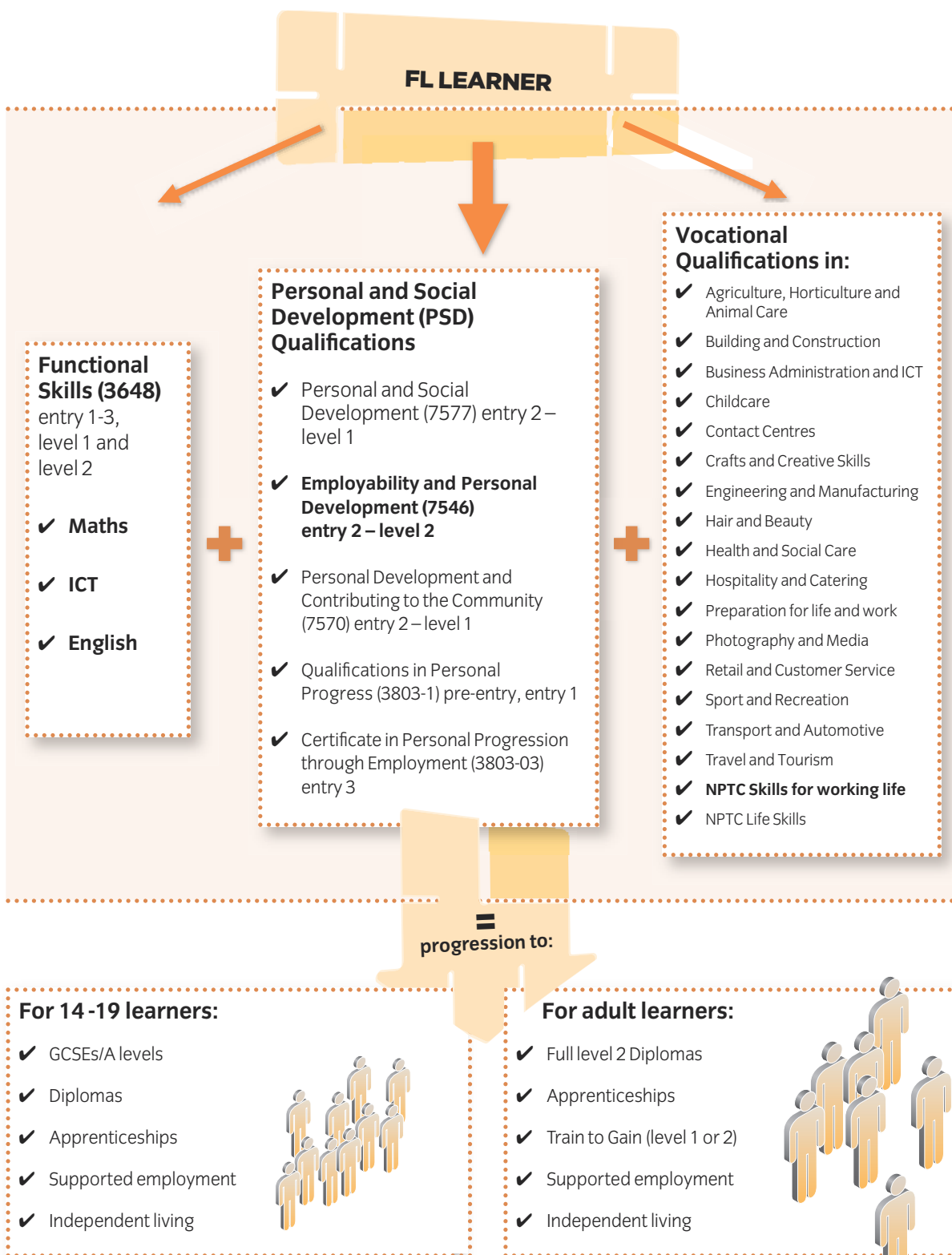

EXAMPLES FROM CITY & GUILDS

Example 1:
Destination – apprentice in a contact centre
Vocational:
 Level 1 Certificate in Introduction to the Contact Centre Industry (4424) *14 credits*
PSD:
 Entry 3 Award in Personal and Social Development (7577) *4 credits*
Functional Skills:
 English – entry 3, Maths – entry 2, ICT – entry 2 (*5 credits each*)

Example 2:
Destination – working in gardening - whilst taking a full level two qualification in horticulture
PSD:
 NPTC entry 3 Award in Skills for Working Life (3807) *8 credits*
Vocational:
 NPTC level 1 Certificate in Practical Horticultural Skills (7573-01) *18 credits*
Functional Skills:
 English – entry 2, Maths – entry 2, ICT – entry 2 (*5 credits each*)

Example 3:
Destination – working in customer service whilst taking a full level two qualification in Customer Service
Vocational:
 Level 1 Award in Customer Service (8992) *6 credits*
Vocational:
 Entry 3 Award in Using IT (Start IT) (4249) *6 credits*
PSD:
 Level 1 Award in Employability and Personal Development (7546) *9 credits*
Functional Skills:
 English – entry 3, Maths – entry 2, ICT – entry 2 (*5 credits each*)

Example 4:
Destination – studying for a diploma in retail
Vocational:
 Level 1 Certificate in Retail (7536) *12 credits*
PSD:
 Entry 3 Award in Employability and Personal Development (7546) *6 credits*
Functional Skills:
 English – entry 3, Maths – entry 2, ICT – entry 2

Example 5:
Destination - apprentice in a hair and/or beauty salon
Vocational:
 Level 1 Certificate in an Introduction to the Hair and Beauty Sector (3001) *13 credits*
PSD:
 Entry 3 Award in Personal and Social Development (7577) *4 credits*
Functional Skills:
 English – entry 3, Maths – entry 2, ICT – entry 2 (*5 credits each*)

Example 6:
Destination – apprentice in vehicle maintenance
Vocational:
 Level 1 Award in Introduction to Vehicle Maintenance and Repair (7571) *7 credits*
PSD:
 Entry 3 Certificate in Employability and Personal Development (7546) *15 credits*
Functional Skills:
 English – entry 3, Maths – entry 2, ICT – entry 2 (*5 credits each*)

Example 7:
Destination – supported employment
Vocational / PSD:
 Entry 3 Certificate in Personal Progression through Employment (3803-3) *14 credits*
Functional Skills:
 English – entry 1, Maths – entry 1, ICT – entry 1 (*5 credits each*)

Example 8:
Destination – independent living
Vocational / PSD:
 Entry 1 Award in Personal Progress (3803-01) *8 credits*
